At the same time, Trumba Connect offered IFFS a detailed level of control over the appearance of its published events. IFFS not only had a collection of professionally-designed published views to choose among. For each view, IFFS also had the ability to customize colors and fonts.

Goal: Provide ten different tracks of conference events in a clear, easy-to-navigate format

IFFS took advantage of the power and flexibility of Trumba Connect to publish different views of the conference events. In the Conference Grid, attendees see all events in all tracks, with events arranged chronologically. Each track is identified by its own color.



IFFS also made use of one of the widgets that was created automatically when IFFS published its conference events. The Calendar List widget, which IFFS added above the Conference Grid, allows attendees to filter events by track.

In addition to the Conference Grid, IFFS published individual views for each track. From the conference program, attendees have a choice. They can go to the Conference Grid to get an overall picture of the entire conference. Or, if they have a particular interest, they can go directly to a track-specific view.

Goal: Allow attendees to easily build their own personal conference schedules

IFFS wanted conference attendees to easily create their own personal conference schedules built around their own interests. With its interactive events, Trumba Connect provides the perfect solution.



Visitors to the IFFS conference schedules can take a number of different actions with any event they find there. For example, from the Conference Grid or the individual track schedules, attendees can add events to their personal calendars, set email or text message reminders, and arrange to be notified if events change.

They can also subscribe to RSS feeds or add themselves to a distribution list to receive notification of new or updated events.
