Purpose

Trumba corporation's products are used by a wide variety of organizations. Many of these organizations have a large audience for their public-facing web sites. It is essential that users with disabilities be able to effectively access and use web sites that contain content powered by Trumba Corporation. The purpose for this statement is to establish guidelines for the development of Trumba Corporation's policies that enable Trumba's software to be accessible to all users.

Policy Statement

Trumba corporation is committed to ensuring equal access for all users of the company's public facing software. Trumba Corporation has appointed an accessibility team to effectively ensure the public facing components of the product are accessible to all users. The accessibility team is comprised of Trumba's management team.

Scope

This accessibility statement targets software that is to be used by the public. It does not target software used to administer the product (e.g. the Trumba back end).

Trumba Corporation has partnered with accessibility experts at the University of Washington and use WAI-ARIA technology to make Trumba Connect a WCAG 2.0 Level A compliant solution. Trumba Connect, being a fully browser-based application, makes the WAI-ARIA approach an excellent choice to achieve their accessibility goals. Experts in accessibility at the UW, some who themselves are visually impaired, provided technical guidance and testing of the Trumba application.
